Meeting began by **elavuating** the work carried out during the year.

Evaluation of rubbish levels.

The committee agreed that levels of rubbish had increased due to our campaign to make pupils more aware of putting rubbish in the bin. More bags of rubbish had been lifted during May & June (349.8kg) compared to March & April (138.6kg). Success!!

Committee agreed that montiring of rubbish should continue after the summer and that Litter-bug reps (in charge of encouraging people to use bins at break times) should be nominated in Sept 2017.

Committee also agreed that the tidy up day had been worthwhile and that another one should be advertised in Sept 2017.

Evaluation of saving energy.

Committee agreed that involving parents by handing out themometer cards achieved greater awareness of the Eco-school project and encouraged parents to be more aware of saving energy in their own homes.

Committee agreed that the energy saving campaign (posters around the school and also school assembly encouraging children to turn off lights) was susscessful as the energy bills show a decrease in energy used. For example, in April's electiricity bill was £211.57 compared with June's bill of £163.80. SUCCESS!
